As your family plans for on-campus learning, we hope you take a moment to revisit the Reopening Plan that was shared with you in August. In it you will find our health and safety measures, student schedules and activities, and resources to help prepare your student(s) for learning in-person.

TCS continues to monitor the changing guidelines and mandates of <u>St. Louis County</u> and the protocols needed to keep our community safe. Below are updated protocols of the Reopening Plan. This addendum reflects the current needs of our school for reopening and may be subject to change.

REOPENING SCHEDULE

TCS will have a gradual reopening of the building. Below are the start dates for specific grades.

- > September 16: Preschool-K returns to campus fully, all other grades remain virtual;
- > September 23: Lower Division (First Third Grade) returns to campus fully, Upper Division (Fourth Eighth Grade) continues virtually. All students (including Upper Division) may take day trips during this time if conditions allow;
- > September 30: Upper Division (Fourth Eighth Grade) returns to campus fully.

DROPPING OFF AND PICKING UP OF STUDENTS

Families will be assigned to one of four drop-off and pick-up locations. Please review page 10 in the Reopening Plan for a complete list of drop-off and pick-up protocols.

- > All siblings will be dropped off/picked up at the same time and location as the first student being dropped off and picked up.
- > For students in car seats, please follow these guidelines:
 - > Pull up to the entrance of the assigned location and put the car in park.
 - > Parents and students put on a mask inside the car.
 - > Students will remain in the car while a TCS employee takes the student's temperature within the car. Parents will remain in the car.
 - > Parents will help students out of the car seat. A TCS employee will take the student to the front door. Parents will get back into the car.
- > For students not in car seats, please follow these guidelines:
 - > Pull up to the entrance of the assigned location and put the car in park.
 - > Parents and students put on their mask inside the car.
 - > Students will remain in the car while a TCS employee takes the student's temperature within the car. Parents will remain in the car.
 - > Students will walk to their classroom.
- > If a parent has to pick up a child early, the parent must call the school, and the child will be brought to them at the designated door. Please give at least a 30 minute notice of early pick-up.
- > All students must be picked up within their assigned 15 minute pick up time. Late pick-ups will be charged \$5 per minute.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Before and After School Care will not be offered to our families during the fall semester (August - December). While we understand the constraints this may put on our families, we believe this decision will mitigate risk and cross-contamination. We will reevaluate the program for the spring semester (January - May).

MASKS

Please review page 7 of the Reopening Plan for a full list of masks protocols. **TCS will provide each student with two masks.**

- > Starting August 24, <u>St. Louis County</u> requires all students, Kindergarten Eighth Grade, to wear masks at school when you are within 6 feet of people who don't live with you. Masks are required outside unless students are at least 6 feet apart.
- Students should arrive wearing a mask on the first day of school. TCS will provide two additional masks to students when in the classroom.
- > Students will need two masks at school at all times. Masks should be fitted and two-ply. No masks with one-way valves.

SCREENING

All students, faculty, staff, and visitors will need to complete a daily screening questionnaire and temperature checks. For more information about screenings, please review page 7 of the Reopening Plan.

- > Families must complete a screening questionnaire every day before coming to school. <u>Please click here</u> for the questionnaire. We encourage you to bookmark the link or print out the document for easy access.

LUNCH

Lunch will be provided by the TCS kitchen staff every full school day. Lunch will not be provided on half days. For more information about lunch, please refer to page 10 of the Reopening Plan.

- > Families may select their lunch options through this link or the parent portal.
- > Menu will be posted for the entire month. Selections must be made at least a week in advance.
- > Students can choose between the sandwich option or entrée option each day. Students may also choose to receive milk.
- > Individually contained lunches will be delivered daily to students in the classroom. Items will be presented in disposable containers.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Please plan on bringing all school supplies and Chromebook/Tablet with a charging cord to school on your student's first day.
